
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DESIGNATION DES FIXATIONS DE ROUES DE CAMION VERSENKBEZEICHNUNGEN FÜR NUTZFAHRZEUGRÄDER

1 - SCOPE AND FIELD OF APPLICATION

This Euwa specification covers the dimensions of stud holes for truck wheels and the definition of a code to be used as marking on the wheels.

2 - STUD HOLE CODE



Marking the stud hole type on the disc is not compulsory. As far as possible, and especially contingent on agreement of truck makers, this code should be used for any kind of marking of new wheels.

3 - DIMENSIONS AND TOLERANCES

Dimensions and tolerances of the different types of stud holes listed in the following tables are mainly in accordance with ISO 4107. All deviations are indicated.

Main changes compared to the last issue:




3.1 - PLAIN STUD HOLES

Plain stud holes only can be used in combination with hub centring.

Special diameters **d** are marked with "/" followed by divergent diameter.


3.2 - SPHERICAL STUD HOLES

To make it possible to integrate types of stud holes which differ slightly from ISO 4107, the diameter tolerances of stud hole and countersink are enlarged against ISO 4107.

All stud holes for thread diameter 22 are also usable for thread diameter 20 without any changes.

3.3 - CONICAL STUD HOLES

Conical stud holes are not recommended for new design.

To make it possible to integrate types of stud holes which differ slightly from ISO 4107, the diameter tolerances of stud hole and countersink are enlarged against ISO 4107.
